LETTER FROM THE FOUNDATION PRESIDENT

At the Making a Difference Foundation, our core mission is to **help people find their passion in giving back**. We believe anyone, and everyone, can create positive change and often only needs a little support, or the right opportunity, to make a huge difference in communities around the world. Whether it's helping a healthcare provider find their first humanitarian medical mission trip or providing a financial grant to a nonprofit that a CHG Healthcare employee is actively involved, we were created to provide this helping hand.

2018 was our second full year of operations and we made tremendous progress. Internally, we increased our staff to three full-time employees, created and implemented a website, and streamlined our programs and processes. To help support the passion of CHG employees giving back, we provided **\$184,718 in grants** to local charities and **\$270,238 in healthcare focused grants** within the communities where employees live and work. CHG employees showed their support to us late in 2018 by pledging over **\$125,000 in personal contributions** to the foundation during 2019.

Our biggest area of growth came in providing medical mission opportunities to healthcare providers. This year, we increased our nonprofit partnerships to include three top medical mission organizations. In the second half of 2018, we sponsored **19 providers** on four medical missions to **Kenya, Cambodia, Guatemala, and Haiti**. We are thrilled to be able to expand this offering to 13 trips in 2019, giving us the ability to help between 70 and 80 providers give medical care to communities that are either underserved or receive no other medical services at all.

Thank you for your support of the Making a Difference Foundation. In 2019, we will continue to work hard in order to help people find their philanthropic passions and make a difference in their lives and the lives of others.





CHILDREN'S CRANIOFACIAL ASSOCIATION

CHG employee, Margaret Lavender, has a close friend whose son, John, was born with Crouzon Syndrome, a genetic disorder that causes premature fusion of certain skull bones. This early bone fusion prevents the skull from growing normally and affects the shape of the head and face. At the time of his birth, John's parents weren't sure what to do. Thankfully they discovered the Children's Craniofacial Association (CCA). CCA provided them with information to help them educate themselves and their families about Crouzon Syndrome. They were also linked to local physicians and surgeons, provided information about surgeries, and connected to financial assistance programs. John's parents were embraced into a community of families who provided support at a time of much uncertainty.

Margaret has been personally involved with CCA for several years. She has helped with fundraising and served on their board of directors. Margaret came to the Making a Difference Foundation with a grant request idea. While the CCA is able to give invaluable support and information to families, they often found that medical expenses were a heavy burden for some families. Margaret's grant request helped the CCA create a financial assistance fund for purchasing helmets for kids and families in need. We are so proud to partner with Margaret as she makes a difference for children and families in her community!

FAMILIES MOVING FORWARD

John Bonney has been volunteering at Families Moving Forward for several years. Families Moving Forward provides temporary housing to homeless families with children. John has witnessed the ways in which Families Moving Forward helps families long-term with tools to end the cycle of homelessness. As part of his involvement, John organized volunteer projects with his coworkers, provided general maintenance support, and helped put on a Christmas party for more than 50 kids at the center.

John also requested a grant from the Making a Difference Foundation. The grant provided support for a part-time mental health therapist. The therapist worked with approximately 20-24 families, 4-5 couples, and 50 individuals in 2018. John is creating a ripple effect of change. His compassion has touched the lives of parents and children at Families Moving Forward. We are honored to help his ripple effect spread even farther.





LOCAL GRANTS

CHG employees are extremely generous and compassionate. Their local communities are benefiting from the incredible work they are doing. Based on our belief that one person creates a ripple effect of change, the foundation supports the philanthropic passions of CHG employees by supporting local causes important to them. Feeding homeless pets, hosting a prom for teens with cancer, creating a playground for children with autism, and equine therapy for PTSD survivors are just a few of the amazing causes we were able to support in 2018. In addition, the foundation matched 50% of donations made by CHG employees to local United Way organizations.
